

Liminalis 2010 – Call for Papers

"Gender multiplicity and liminality - different strategies worldwide"

Liminalis, 'Journal for Sex/Gender Emancipation and Resistance' focuses on non-hegemonic genders, including different theoretical approaches and activist strategies. The upcoming issue concentrates on gender multiplicities and liminalities and their different strategies worldwide.

Genders and sexualities are historically specific and vary locally. Western societies have, for example, produced binary and heteronormative gender regimes, which restrict the number of legitimized genders and gender expressions. However, the exclusionary, discriminatory and oppressive effects of hegemonic prescriptions provoke resistance in manifold ways and besides others produce via reclaiming and alteration liminal subject positions via reclaiming and such as trans* and inter*.

Apart from inviting papers which take a critical theoretical and/or strategic stance towards the gender regime mentioned above, we particularly welcome papers which engage with other modes of gendering and resistance to normative notions of gender in different places in the world. We accept contributions in English, German and Spanish.
